ASDA & M&S fresh produce will be available to customers free, with some items frozen on their use by date offered for 1 to 2 points. This week, there were even daffodils as a treat! Our volunteers love to help with meal ideas and there are recipe books people can browse and take a photo of to try back home. Customers pay £3 & have 10 points to spend on non-perishables and toiletries. While most items are 1 point, we have baked beans, evaporated milk, condensed milk & dried spaghetti/ pasta on a **2 for 1 offer**! The spaghetti equates to £1.50 worth, for just 30p so is an amazing bargain.

By attending every week, customers are helping us to cover the room hire whilst helping lower their own household budget. We have vacancies for some regular volunteers also. A perk of being on our rota, is a complimentary shop, the week of volunteering.
