The 'Allotment Army' has been busy: volunteers Tom & Jon worked hard to continue digging over very weedy beds. Ngaire continued to tame a overgrown area, and in doing so, we have a growing log pile situated in the shade of a chestnut tree, which will hopefully encourage wildlife

Jon also erected two little notice boards inside the shed for us to sharing plan, ideas & 'To-Do' lists.
