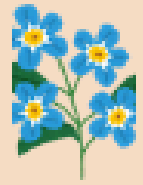
Wednesday / Friday Luncheons - Member Spaces available!

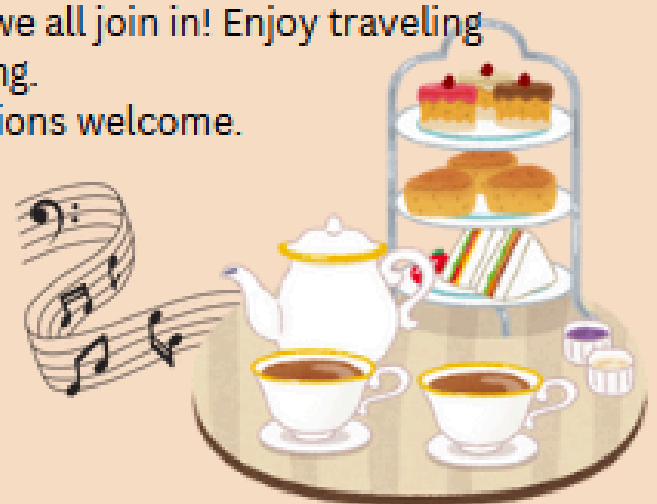

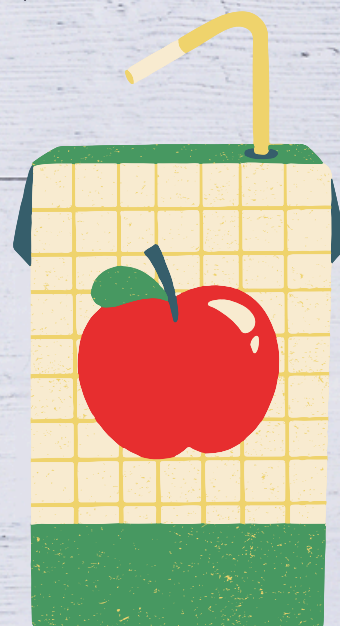
